

**4** **Basilica of Notre-Dame**  
51460 L'Epine

The adjective « flamboyant » is used to describe the late Gothic style of the basilica. It is famous for its sculpted gables and pinnacles and the profusion of gargoyles. You can also admire the stone rood screen as well as the entombment.

**5** **Church of Notre-Dame-en-Vaux**  
Rue de Vaux - 51000 Châlons-en-Champagne

The former collegiate church is flanked by two towers with lead-covered spires. Beautiful Champagne stained glass windows (16<sup>th</sup> century) illuminate the nave.  
*Church open from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., closed Sundays. Guided tour during summer festival in July and August, and few Saturdays per year.*

# Unesco Sites in Champagne-Ardenne



Champagne-Ardenne has 5 sites classified as World Heritage by Unesco, so recognizing them an exceptional worldwide worth.

A veritable consecration for these sites steeped in history, such as the Cathedral of Notre-Dame in Reims, where the Kings of France were crowned for eight centuries or the Church of Notre-Dame-en-Vaux in Châlons-en-Champagne and the Basilica of L'Epine, on the Way of St James.

## 1 Notre-Dame Cathedral 51100 Reims

This exceptional masterpiece of Gothic art is one of the most major architectural achievements of mediaeval Europe. From 1223 to 1825, it played host to the coronations of 25 kings of France. You can also admire the stained glass windows in the axial chapel created by Marc Chagall.

Open every day from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (7:15 pm on sunday). Free visits, guided or audio-guided tours. Guided tour of the towers and upper parts (for a fee).

## 2 Basilica of Saint-Remi royal Abbey 53 rue Simon - 51100 Reims

The Basilica kept in a bronze shrine the relics of St Remi, the bishop who baptised Clovis around 498. The former royal abbey is now home to the city's museum of history and archaeological collections.

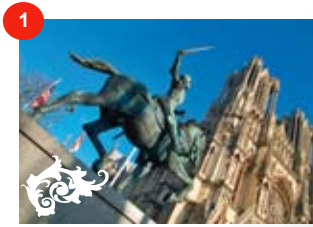
Basilica open every day from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (at nightfall during the winter). Free visits, guided or audio-guided tours. Saint-Remi Museum open from 2 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. (7 p.m. Saturday and Sunday), closed certain bank holidays.

## 3 The Tau Palace 2 place du Cardinal Luçon - 51100 Reims

The Palace was the residence of the Kings of France when they were in the city for their coronation. In its Museum, the palace kept the former cathedral statuary and its royal treasure.

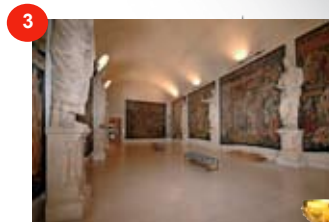
Open daily, except Mondays, 9.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 5.30 p.m. Free or guided tours.

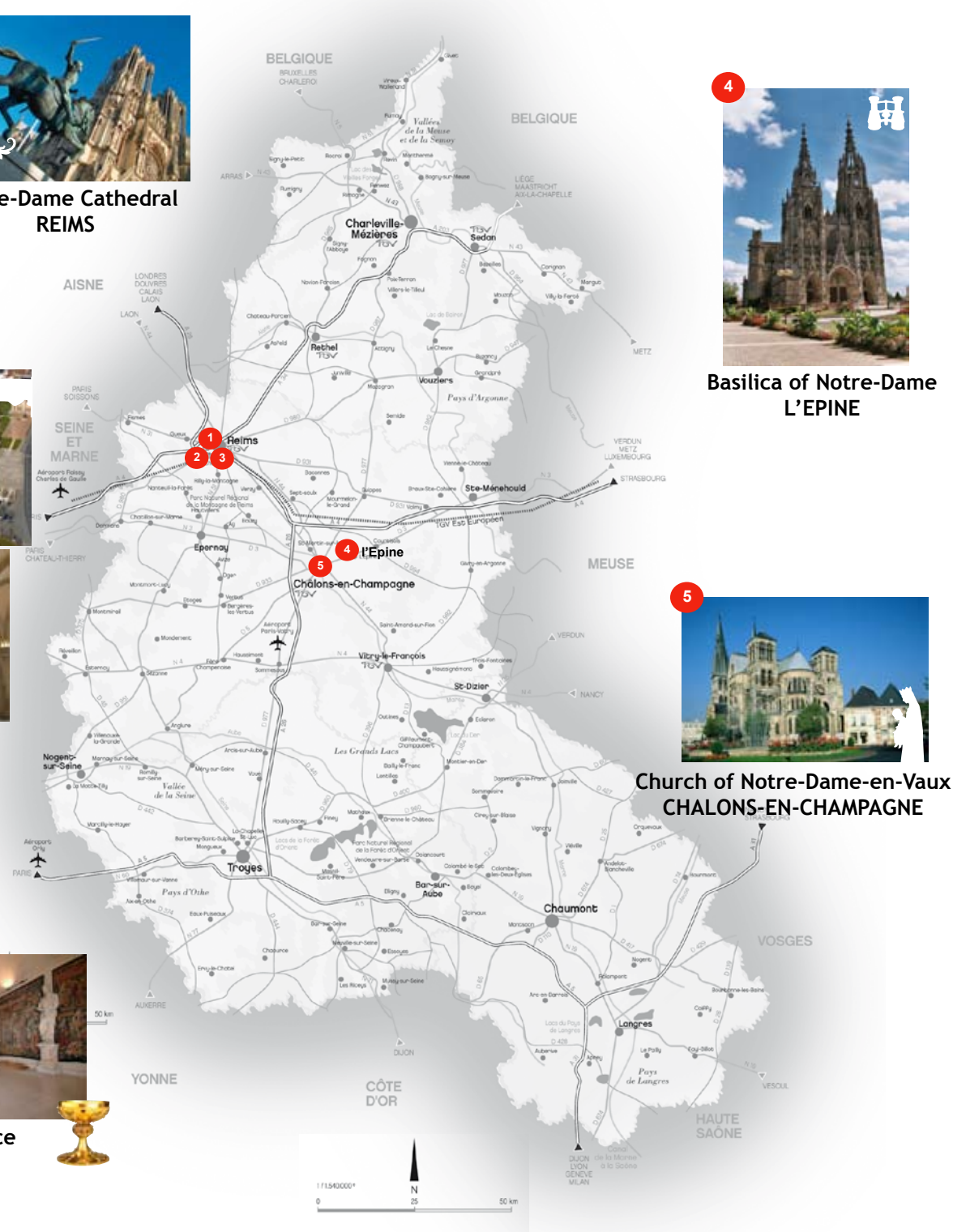
